

A message from Rabbi Daniel Victor

"When we reopen the synagogue there needs to be someone at the doors checking everyone in, everyone who comes in has to carry a smile, and the volunteer has to say, welcome back," said by a child of the congregation.

It has been seven weeks of isolation; individuals and families being relegated to their homes and kept away from open gatherings, whether sacred, social, recreational, or vocational. Yet communities have shown resilience amidst challenging times. Major holidays were significantly altered but were nonetheless marked with joy and dedication. Secular and religious milestones are being held virtually, and with zest, true to the adage, "The show must go on."

But how long can we keep up community morale? The saying, "This too shall pass," is losing its hold on the spirit. We are now at an inflection point along this difficult path, and it is time to decide as a community how to move forward during this next phase. This process will require careful thought and dialogue as we try to apply practical guidance while honoring our core values. There is intense pressure and yearning to re-open quickly, but the burden is upon us to respond responsibly for we will be held accountable for every step we take

What is the focus of our strategic plans for reopening? A well-thought out plan must address things like shifting rates of infection and mortality, or the progress in developing treatments and even a vaccine. Yet hearing about the "measurables" that will lead to a plan for the restarting of physical proximity is only the beginning.

Our plan needs to reflect our values, and we will have to decide how central those values are to any decision making process. One value upon which our movement puts a premium is "Sakanat Nefeshot -- "Endangering Life," which refers to our leaders (clergy, staff, and volunteers) not being put in positions where they will be unduly endangering their own lives or the lives of their families due to pressure to restore activities. A second is "Kol Yisrael Areivim Zeh Bazeh -- We Are Responsible for One Another," which charges each of us to look out for the mental and physical health and safety of one another. We must be sure that we act in ways in which clergy, staff, and participants do not feel discriminated against, or unduly disadvantaged, based on health or other conditions of need.

Beyond the values we will need practical guidance. We must consider seating, flow and crowd control. What about prayer books? What will be done regarding bathroom facilities and proper ventilation in meeting rooms?

Our leadership has created a team to develop a plan that represents our values of health and safety, respect and community. We sincerely ask for your patience as we develop our plan to move forward. Our clergy, staff, and lay-leaders are open to hearing your feelings, ideas, comments, or suggestions. We are dedicated to empowerment and inclusion, and we know that the wise person listens to, and learns from, everyone.

I believe it is a blessing that we have so many places to turn for comfort, education, and inspiration. Your leadership, synagogue, community, and movement, are here to provide YOU with support, direction, connection, and encouragement.

I am confident that the path to standing together once again as a *kehilah kedusha* (a sacred community) will emerge soon, and when it does, we will walk it together. In peace and safety,

#### Tikkun Olam Project

The 4, 5, & 6 grade class, which meets on Sundays for Judaic Studies, decided to take on a Tikkun Olam (repairing the world) project this year. A company in Indiana, Green Tree Plastics, collects plastic bottle caps and turns them into commercial grade outdoor benches.

The class continues to collect clean caps which are recycle #2, #4, #5. When we have collected the number of pounds required, we will turn the caps in to the company and get the bench of our choice. The bench will be put in the backyard where the children play for recess.

This project will most likely take the whole year to collect, sort and weigh the caps. Students are an integral part of the process utilizing their math skills as well as skills in cooperation and visual sorting according to a particular criteria.


