



A message from Rabbi Daniel Victor

Praying with Your Feet

These famous words were said by Rabbi Abraham Joshua Heschel when asked about having marched along side Martin Luther King Jr. The words recently came to my mind when a discussion posed on my Rabbinical Assembly (RA) list serve caught my eye. A question was raised about the permissibility, or even the feasibility, of using a walking treadmill while zooming morning minyan. I was intrigued by the question, perhaps because I have not been exercising enough during this pandemic, and so this past week I gave it a try one weekday morning. I began the morning's experiment feeling that the idea of combining praying and walking had some merit. After all the psalmists tell us, "All my bones shall declare your glory." I am a

davenner who likes to have my body moving while I pray. Furthermore, we are meant to face east (towards Jerusalem) when we stand during minyan, so in a sense, rather than facing Jerusalem, I would be walking towards it – how thrilling! NPR radio has done several

articles about multitasking and how scientists have shown that one who attempts to do two things at once does each one less well. These findings showed themselves to have merit while I was trying to walk and pray. I had to pause the treadmill and step off the center of the treadmill for the first Mourner's Kaddish, of course. When it came time for Barchu bowing from the waist was difficult – which was true for Aleinu at the end of the service as well. Three steps back and three steps forward for the Amidah, was the biggest challenge. In the end, moving the body during prayer can be a big part of one's spiritual practice, but walking when serving Hashem should probably be reserved for when you are walking for a cause, with many people walking side-by-side with you.

We have come round again to spring in the beautiful Hudson Valley. We have run fully remote TBE Education Programs—Early Childhood, Sunday School & Joint TBE/SC Ivrit for grades 3-6, B'nai Mitzvah Classes, and the Gesher Teen Program, for more than a year without ever setting foot in a classroom.

When we reflect on what we have accomplished educationally, it is simply astounding. Our creative, flexible (and now very tech-savvy) faculty have fully realized the vision we created last spring. We wanted to keep everyone safe, but not sacrifice our academic excellence or our commitment to experiential learning.

In many ways, we have done what we always do. We worked, studied and celebrated. Our youngest students have learned about holidays, Shabbat and been introduced to the alef-bet. Our 3rd and 4th graders have learned to read Hebrew, as well as begun to study Torah. Our 5th and 6th graders have explored Israel and learned the prayers for the Torah Service. Our B'nai Mitzvah Class has become a group of service leaders and Torah readers. And our teens have done social action, socialized, studied a variety of topics, and decompressed at Gesher.

The pandemic has created unexpected opportunities to learn and innovate. All of us have found new depths of patience with the challenges of technology and with each other. We have discovered new ways to utilize ordinary household items as learning tools. And, we are now experts at packaging information into small, easily digestible, video-friendly bytes. Some of the changes to our programs will be incorporated into next year's curriculum. Students, parents, and teachers all agree that weekly, remote individual lessons have been a great success. We are very proud of all that our students and families have accomplished this year.


